 - (2) Attach \$25 nonrefundable application fee.
 - DEGREE-ORIENTED (1) Submit:
 - (a) Official high school transcript or GED report.
 - (b) Official transcripts from all colleges, universities and technical schools attended.
 - (c) SAT scores (only if applicant is **under** 21 years of age.)
 - (2) Schedule a personal interview.
 - NON-DEGREE, PRE-MBA, and AUDIT STUDENTS Submit evidence of last level of educational attainment (transcript or diploma copy). If a no-degree student earns 18 semester hours or decides to degree status, he/she must provide a full set of official transcripts.
