EDEX 742:	Procedures for Teaching Individuals with Exceptional Learning Needs II: Grade 6 through Transition (3) <i>Prerequisites: EDEX 621 and 623</i>
EDEX 745:	Social and Behavioral Interventions (3)
*EDEX 963:	Practicum in Teaching Students with Emotional/Behavioral Disorders (3) <i>Prerequisites: EDEX 741, 742, and 745 or permission of instructor May be taken concurrently only with EDFD 879.</i>

Exit Requirement (3 hours)

EDFD 879:	Master's Seminar in Education (3) <i>Must be the last course in the degree program. May be taken concurrently only with EDEX 963.</i>
