Someone brought up the response to Bush coming to Furman – it was suggested that another example be found.**

**Brian Highsmith – the CORE data. How have things changed since the Vinnings is wet? These numbers will be helpful however; we are still in the infant stage. Jason Cassidy said that he got an email today from a resident saying they will not renew contract due to the problems with students.**

**What about the students who don't want alcohol there? – Spencer suggested a dry building. Will sanctioning be stricter? It should be if the policy changes.**
