

May Experience Subcommittee Meeting
October 4, 2007
Minutes

1. The minutes from the May 2, 2007 meeting were approved.
2. The committee revisited the questions for the Course Proposal System's section on the May Experience, and considered adding additional questions that will help faculty structure their May courses. We will continue to discuss this matter.
3. There was some discussion concerning how May courses might operate for students in the Furman Advantage summer research program. If Advantage students were to begin their 10-week research immediately following the May term, very little free summer time would remain. If Advantage students were to overlap the May term with their research, other problems might develop. The Furman Advantage committee may soon consider this issue.
4. The CRC document contains no rule concerning the number of May courses that students may take in one May term. The committee believes that the intention of the Curriculum Review Committee was to limit each student to one course in each May term. The ITF Steering committee will be asked to consider this question.
