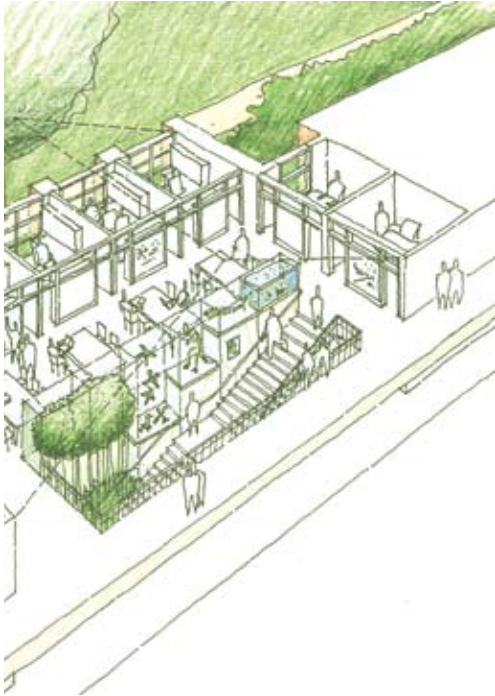


TOWNES CENTER FOR SCIENCE

A \$4 million challenge grant has been issued by four alumni couples and friends to complete the final \$6 million in this \$32.2 million fundraising project. For every \$1 pledged between now and August 31, 2007, they will give \$2, until the project is completed. Pledges may be paid over a period of five years, and by taking advantage of this challenge, your Furman investment will yield an immediate 200 percent return.

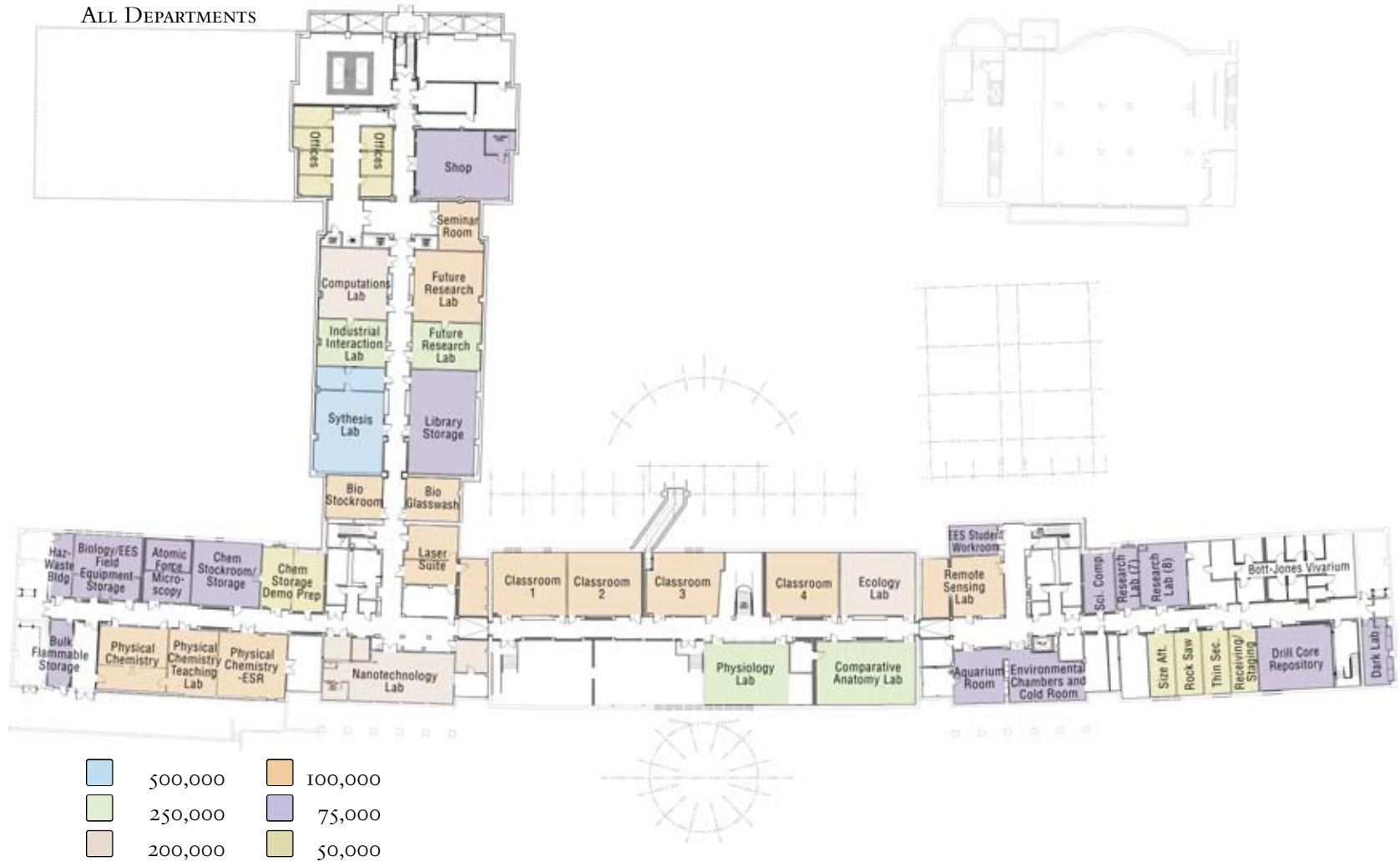

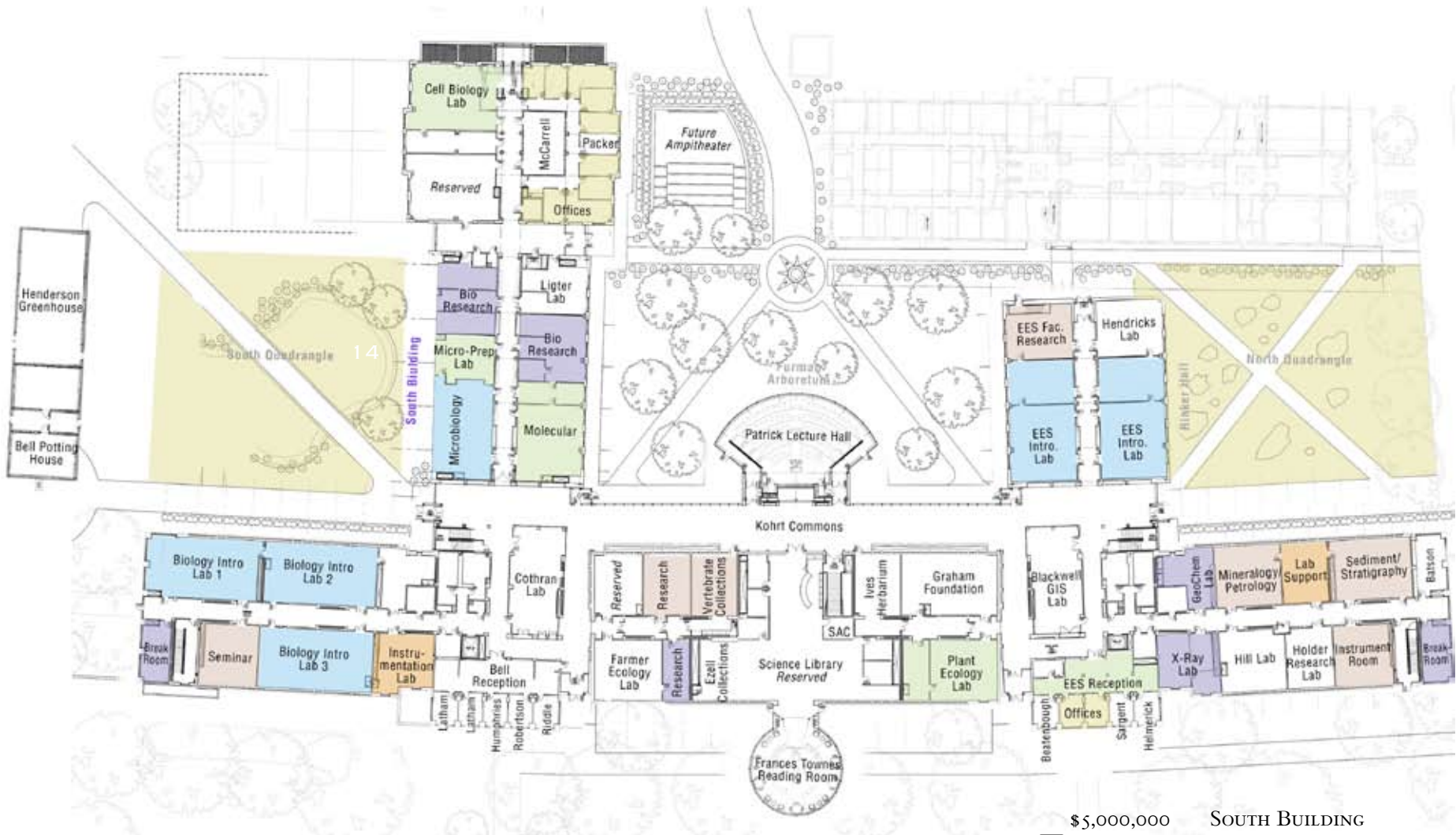
The total cost of the two new buildings linked to Plyler Hall, the complete renovation of Plyler, new outdoor teaching quadrangles, greenhouse and sustainability systems, is estimated to be \$61.5 million. It will increase the space for the natural sciences by nearly 50 percent. Nearly one half of the cost will be underwritten by a low-interest bond issue. The other half is sought from alumni, parents and friends of Furman who appreciate the vital role of the sciences and undergraduate research at Furman University.

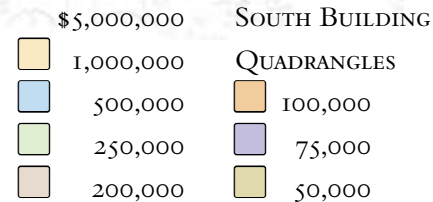




GROUND LEVEL
