Job Shadowing experiences for rising Sophomores in Greenville during the academic year and in other key cities (i.e., Atlanta, Charlotte).

Information sessions and recruitment events with area organizations about internships they offer during both the academic year as well as during the summer months.

Annual recognition and celebration of internship experiences through *Furman Engaged!*, Family Weekend, and other events & activities.

Services

Summer Fellowships to support low or unpaid, full-time internships.

Networking with alumni and parents of current and former students who provide opportunities for information interviews to help students better position themselves for internships in highly competitive markets.

Collaborations with campus partners to co-sponsor events such as Opportunity Fairs, Career Panels, Alumni Webinars, etc.
