urman has always supported student-athletes, with heavy emphasis on **student**. Our athletes are competitors in the classroom and on the field, rising to the occasion to meet Furman's rigorous academic and training schedules. To compete at their best, they depend upon outstanding coaches, excellent training and competition facilities, and a relentless commitment to maintaining the competitive edge that winning in the Southern Conference and in NCAA Division I sports require.

ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIPS

Furman is the smallest DI school in the Southern Conference, and we award more athletic scholarships than any other league member, totaling about \$13 million a year. But only \$1.3 million of the \$13 million is endowed, requiring the annual operating budget to fund 90% of these scholarships. Donors can make permanent the capacity of our student-athletes to compete and win through endowed scholarships that provide a lasting resource or those investments.
