FERPA

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) affords eligible students certain rights with respect to their education records. FERPA's regulations define "education records" as those records that are (1) directly related to a student and (2) maintained by Furman University or by a party acting on behalf of Furman. In general, among other rights and subject to exceptions, FERPA gives you the right to control the disclosure of your education records to others.

Disclosure to Your Parents or Spouse
