You may enroll in credit-bearing courses on a non-credit credit basis as an auditor during the drop-add period for a term. Any course enrolled as an audit will not contribute towards the Furman degree and will not be used to compute your GPA. Additionally, an audited course may not be used to fulfill prerequisites or any other academic requirements.

You must obtain permission from the instructor, department chair, and your advisor to audit a course. Before submitting a request, you must meet with the instructor to agree on the explicit conditions required of the audit. Ordinarily, students who audit will do all assigned reading and participate in class discussions, but will not be required to submit written work or take exams. Students seeking to audit a course for which they have previously received credit must receive permission from the course instructor and the appropriate department chair. The inverse is also true in that once a course has been successfully audited, students must gain permission from the course instructor and department chair to complete the course again for credit.

Satisfactory completion of an audit will be designated on your academic record, while unsuccessful attempts will not appear.
