

## **COVID Vaccine Policy**

### **Osher Lifelong Learning Institute at Furman University**

Those participating in Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI) at Furman events and programs in the Fall 2021 term will need to provide proof of vaccination, or complete a form acknowledging that they are not vaccinated, in order to participate in OLLI and other campus programs. While the vaccine is not required for participation, collecting this information will help Furman's COVID response teams understand the rate of vaccinations within the campus community, which will help them make decisions about campus operations. For those who remain unvaccinated, close contact exposures to positive cases will necessarily result in quarantine from campus for 10 days symptom-free, or 7 days symptom-free with a negative PCR test acquired 5-6 days after exposure.

You may submit proof of vaccination in any of the following ways:

- Scan or photocopy your vaccination card and email it to [OLLI@Furman.edu](mailto:OLLI@Furman.edu)
- Bring your card, or a photocopy of your card, or a picture of your card to the OLLI office and present to a staff member.
- Mail a photocopy of the card to Nancy Kennedy, OLLI@Furman, 3300 Poinsett Highway, Greenville, SC 29613.

OLLI will not retain copies of your card. Any copies received in the office will be destroyed after it is noted in our records that a staff member has seen proof of vaccination.

OLLI participants who have chosen not to have the vaccine, or have not yet received it, will need to sign an Acknowledgement of Expectations provided by Furman. These are available upon request in the OLLI office, or via email (request from Nancy Kennedy).
