

  - Find and click the name of the class you'd like to evaluate.



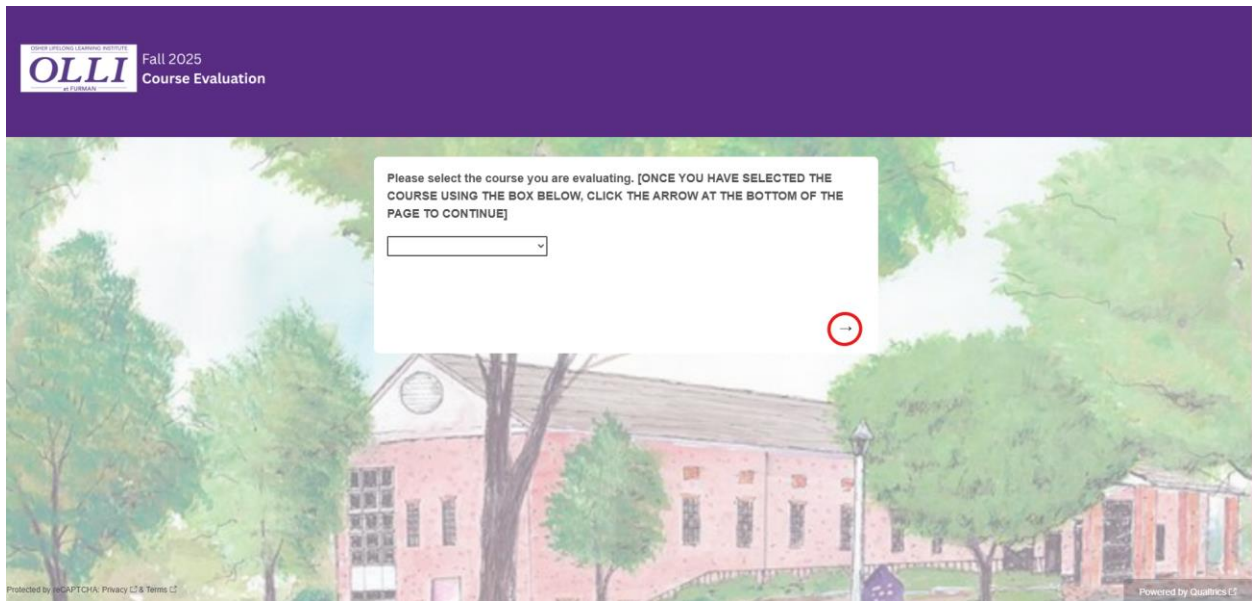

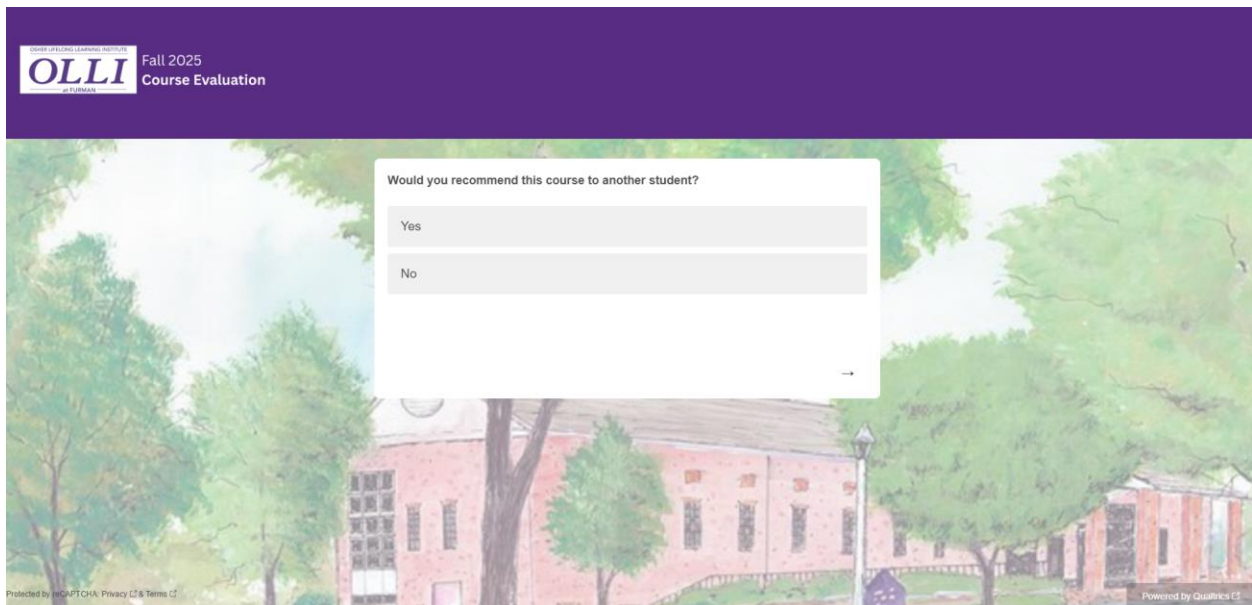
