Shi Center for Sustainability, the Community Conservation Corps, nor Habitat for Humanity of Greenville County nor its agents, contractors, directors, employees, officers, volunteers or other representatives are liable for any damages to any person or to any property in any way caused by or resulting from the performance of the weatherization process, except as caused by the negligence or willful misconduct of any of the above-designated persons/entities.

_____ I agree and understand that if my home is deemed unsafe or unacceptable for weatherization contractors, auditors, or volunteers to perform their duties, the project will be postponed until these conditions are corrected. Unsafe or unacceptable conditions include, but are not limited to:

- Any hoarding activities, defined as the acquisition of and failure to remove a large amount of possessions that prevent accessibility throughout the residence.
- The presence/consumption of drugs or alcohol while staff and/or volunteers are in the home
- The presence of guns or other weapons left in the open
- More than 8 uncaged pets living in the home
- The presence of mold
- Severe infestation of any sort including bed bugs, cockroaches, rodents, etc.
- Structural damage that would prevent the effectiveness of a weatherization, including, but not limited to, roof leaks, holes in walls/floors, severe water damage, etc.

_____ I authorize the release of income and utility usage records to the Community Conservation Corps.

_____ I also hereby state that no one in my household has any judgments against them; the mortgage on my home is not delinquent, in forbearance, or involved in an ongoing foreclosure case; and my home is not for sale or being prepared for use as a rental property.
