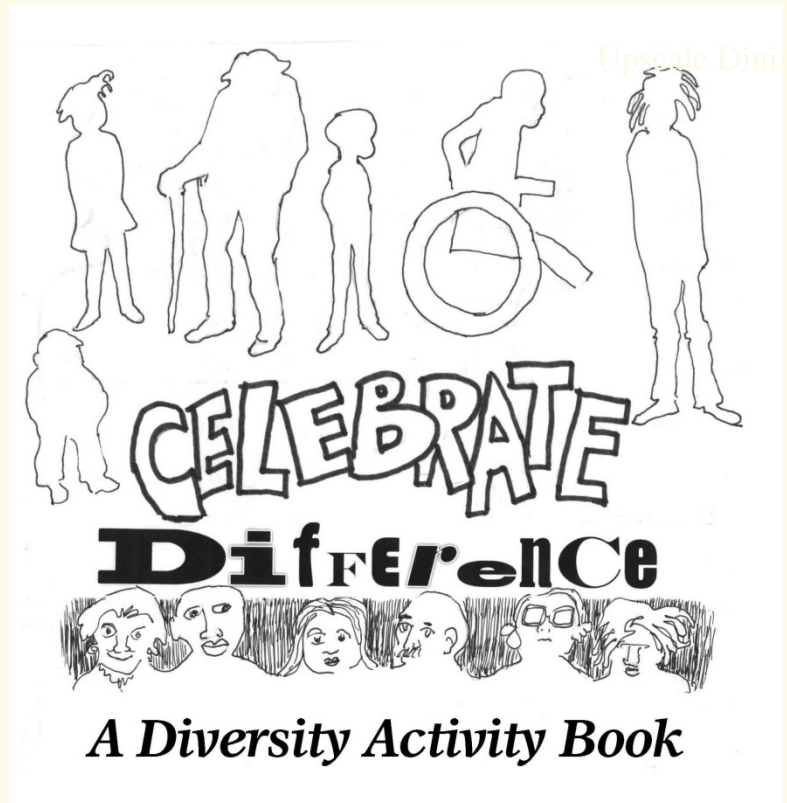

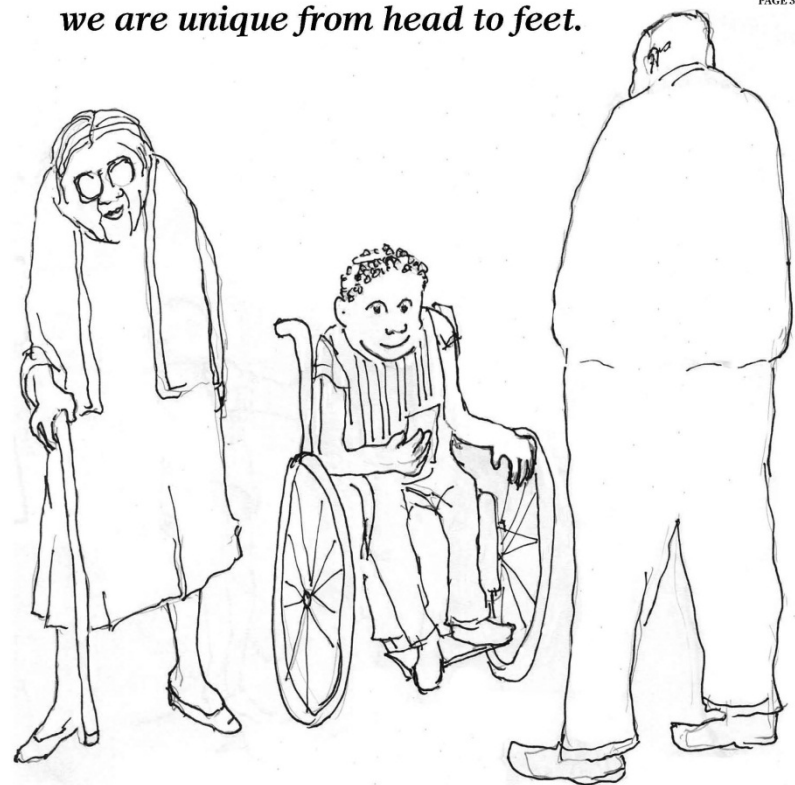

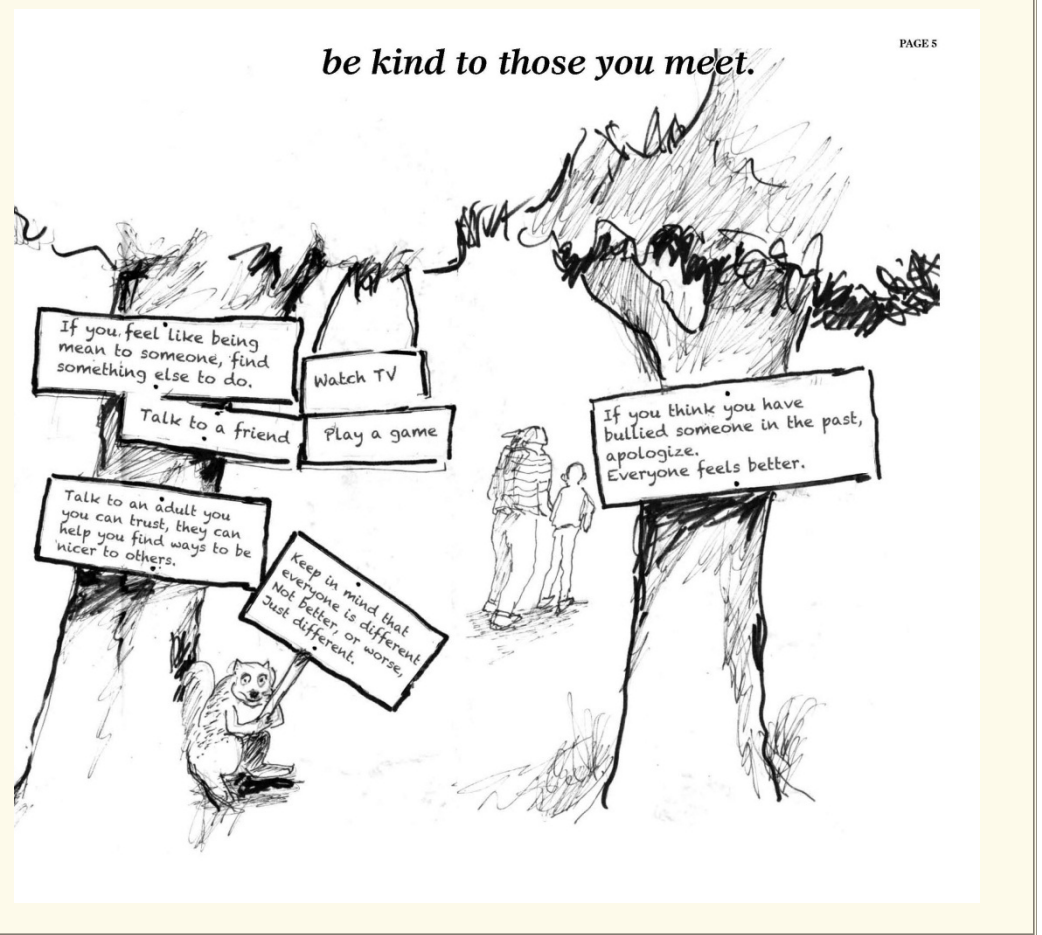
BE KIND TO THOSE YOU MEET...

WORLD MAP

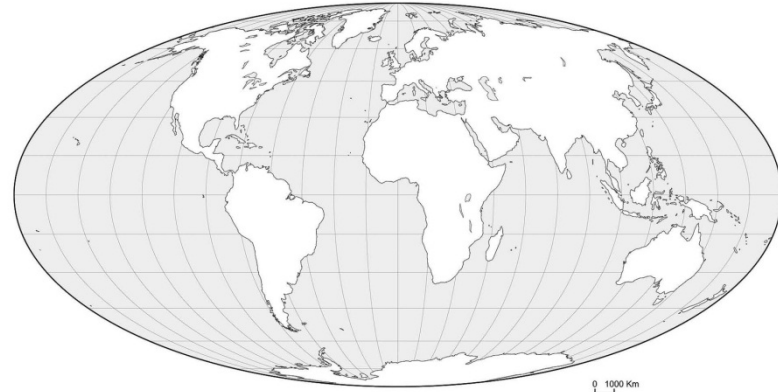
People come from different countries around the world.
